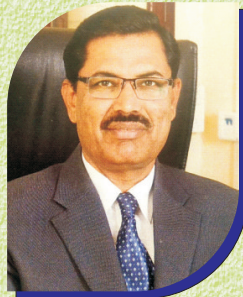

Concept Note
